"The night shift aides on 300 hall at Towne Center celebrated a resident's birthday as he had no family that visited him. They brought him cake and presents. They made him feel like a king. The aides are his family at Towne Center and gave him a moment he won't forget."

"I have always said that our STNAs are the backbone of our team. They are the face of our facility, the direct caregivers seen daily by our residents. The job is not glamorous, and it cannot be done without the willingness to 'get your hands dirty' and perform tasks that residents cannot complete themselves. STNAs work very hard, and their dedication to the lives of our residents is truly inspiring."

"An STNA took a resident with no family home for Thanksgiving, and he was thrilled to be a part of a family gathering. Aides have brought in home cooked food, Christmas gifts, favorite body wash, clothing, cupcakes - anything to make someone's day. Our residents are family!"

### **Meet WellSpring Administrator Herbert Grigat!**

Please help us welcome Herbert Grigat to the WellSpring team!

Herbert is the Regional Administrator at WellSpring. He comes to the organization with over 30 years of experience in the healthcare and hospice industry. His passion for helping others began when he was a young man serving in the German Army Special Forces as an Officer and Medic. Upon exiting the military, he graduated from nursing school where he received his MSN in Public Health, earned his MBA in Medical Management and Education, worked in a hospital Intensive Care Unit, became Chief Nursing Officer (CNO) of a 740-bed clinic and started working as a Consultant.



Some of his greatest learning lessons and one of his greatest honors, however, came after receiving the opportunity to intern with Dame Cicely Saunders, otherwise known as the "Florence Nightingale" and founder of the hospice industry, for three months.

"She changed my life professionally," said Herbert. "She was a visionary and the people loved her. After my time with her, I started to view the healthcare industry in a new light, started to notice differences between healthcare in Europe and the U.S., and began to spot areas for improvement not only for patients but for the families and staff members."

Now at WellSpring, he has big goals for the brand and is excited to bring his vast experience to the company.

"I see ourselves becoming the #1 go-to organization for any medical needs that do not require hospitalization but I know it's going to take time, committed team members and us going out into the community to make connections. I'm optimistic about the future and with the support of senior leadership, I'm confident of our ability to make a difference."

Looking ahead, Herbert said he's eager to develop a core team that he hopes will include a certified wound care specialist and nutritionist in addition to offering mental health services for families, patients and staff members. - New problems with with words in speech or writing
- Misplacing things and losing the ability to retrace steps
- Decreased or poor judgement
- Withdrawal from work or social activities
- Changes in mood or personality

If you or a loved one is experiencing any of these symptoms, we urge you to visit a doctor to get tested for Alzheimer's. Early detection is critical to maximizing your treatment options and offer you more time to plan and prepare for the future.
